We published the results of our 2012 Patient Questionnaire on our website and have discussed these results and agreed an Action Plan with our PPG. The Action Plan covers 3 main issues and is detailed below:

Memory+

We have been approached by Leicestershire County Council's (LCC) Communities and Wellbeing Service to take part in an exciting new pilot that has been designed specifically to help people with varying levels of dementia.

There are more than 9000 people in Leicestershire living with dementia; often the difficult task of caring for these individual falls upon their family members.

Hugglescote Surgery is committed to supporting people to live well with dementia and improving the quality of their day to day lives; with a view to help them live longer at home. This includes the person with dementia and their carers.

We are offering to run a pilot in partnership with LCC to test a new "Memory Plus" training workshop. The workshop will be designed to equip family carers with the skills and confidence to engage with their loved one in meaningful, stimulating and multi-sensory activities including reminiscence.

The workshop will be suitable for anyone who is either a carer or an individual supporting someone caring for a person living with dementia and will be held at Ravenstone Village Institute on Wednesday 28th June 2017 from 2pm – 4pm.
